#2 Red Earth Farm

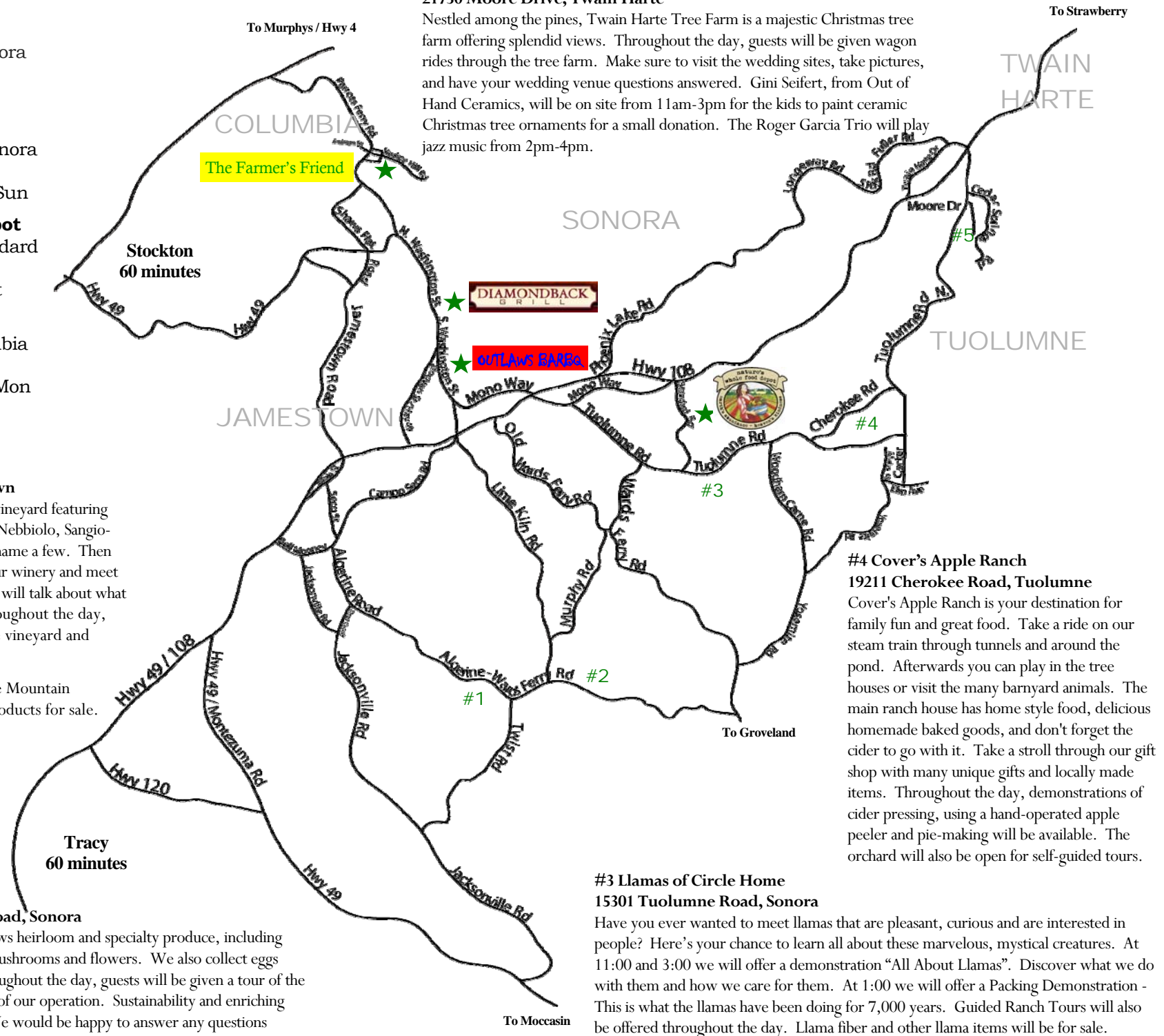
